

1. PERFORMANCE

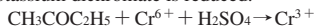
- 1) Measuring range : 1.0-5.0 % 0.05-2.2 %
 Number of pump strokes : 1/2 (50mℓ) 1 (100mℓ)
- 2) Sampling time : 1.5 minutes/1 pump stroke
- 3) Detectable limit : 50 ppm
- 4) Shelf life : 3 years
- 5) Operating temperature : 0 ~ 40 °C
- 6) Reading : Graduations printed on the tube are calibrated by Ethylene oxide at 1 pump stroke and Methyl ethyl ketone is determined by using a conversion chart.
- 7) Colour change : Orange → Dark brown

Potassium dichromate is reduced.

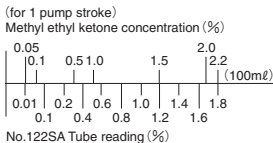
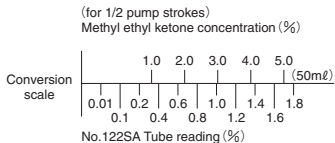
